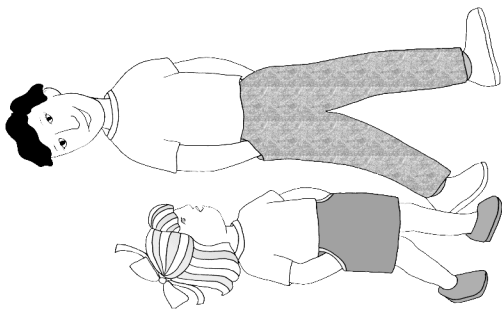

This pocket chart activity includes a header card, graphing cards, and a graphing sheet.

Teacher directions: Print game pieces onto cardstock and laminate for durability. Print graphing sheets onto regular paper, one for each student as desired.


Student directions: Choose which card best describes how you travel to school. The choices are a bus, a car, walking, and riding a bike.

Using the graphing sheet, put tally marks in the center column to record how your classmates travel to school. Total up the tally marks in the last column.


