





Pumpkin Plant Sequencing



Pumpkin Plant Sequencing

- 1. Soil is ready for planting seeds.
- 2. Seeds are planted in the soil.
- 3. Watering the seeds so they will grow.
- 4. Seeds begin to sprout.
- 5. The small plants grow.
- 6. The plants grow larger, and make pumpkins.



Directions

Print sequencing cards, and laminate. Use for a pocket chart activity, or as a memory game.

Students can turn cards over and take turns putting them in order.

Practice sequencing by telling the story of how seeds become pumpkins.
