Pumpkin Plant Sequencing

1. Soil is ready for planting seeds.
2. Seeds are planted in the soil.
3. Watering the seeds so they will grow.
4. Seeds begin to sprout.
5. The small plants grow.
6. The plants grow larger, and make pumpkins.



Directions

Print sequencing cards, and laminate. Use for a pocket chart activity, or as a memory game.

Students can turn cards over and take turns putting them in order.

Practice sequencing by telling the story of how seeds become pumpkins.
